GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

This permit is for motor trucks only and not for truck-tractor/trailer combinations. It is valid to transport raw milk to or from a milk plant, receiving station, or transfer station. It is not valid for interstate travel.

Maximum weight allowed with this permit is 20,000 pounds per axle; not to exceed 80,000 pounds total gross weight. Weight on tires must not exceed manufacturer's rating.

A copy of this permit must be carried in the vehicle at all times and be available for inspection upon the request of any peace office.

Necessary state and/or city permits must be obtained separately.

Must comply with all bridge postings.

Must provide route and/or map for approval by County Engineer.
